**Message from Dr. Lakshminarayana Merugu,
Chair, IEEE Hyderabad Section**

IEEE Hyderabad Section has completed an eventful year 2016, and as we enter 2017, hope that the Section would be more active and direct its efforts to provide a valuable experience to all its members. 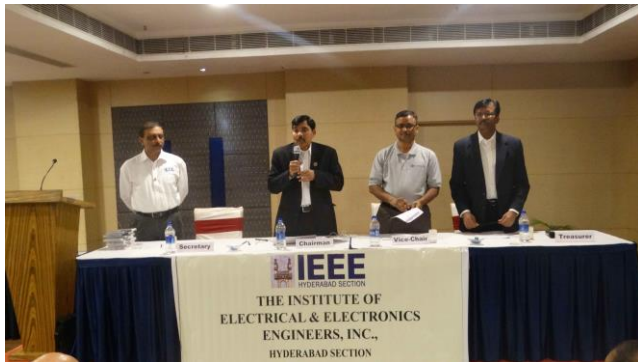

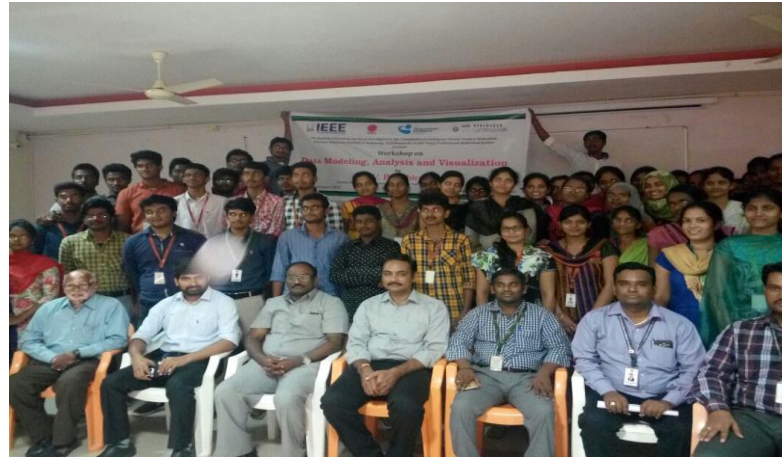
Workshop on UAV/Drones organised by IRC

The speaker briefed the participants about various Renewable Energy supplies, concept of Micro grid and distributed Generation. Also, emphasis on advantages of Renewable Energy supplies along with their reliability with computational Intelligence approach especially by choosing Cuckoo Search Algorithm. He compared the Cuckoo Search Algorithm with conventional Particle Swam Optimization for reducing system generation cost and emission cost.



Technical Talk on DEEP LEARNING – THE HYPE, THE MYTH AND THE REALITY

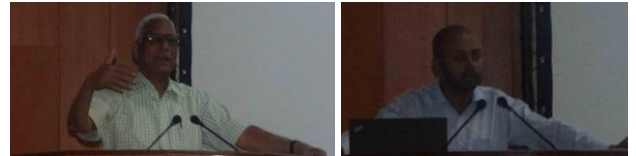


IEEE CIS Chapter Membership Promotion Program - Computational Intelligence - Technology Expo and Collaboration Hotspot (CITECH)
