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Gandhigram Rural Institute – DU, Gandhigram had his M. Sc and Ph. D from Regional Engineering College, Trichy, now known as National Institute of Technology, Trichy. He has 30 years of teaching and 34 years of research experience. His areas of specialisation include Natural Products Chemistry and Surface protection strategies. Prof. Sethuraman has published 130 research articles in leading International Journals with good impact factors and his publications are widely cited. Eighteen scholars have been awarded Ph. D under his guidance and Six scholars are presently working under his guidance. He has delivered more than 342 invited talks in various National and International Conferences both in India and abroad. Prof. Sethuraman has completed eight research projects.
