R. Balasubmanina, Vice Chair called to order the Fifth SEC meeting of IEEE Hyderabad Section at 2:00PM on May 23, 2021 through Virtual meeting over WebEx to discuss on Chapter, Joint Chapters, Affinity Group and Subsection Activity Planning. Sreenivas Jasti, Chapter Chair could not attend due to unavoidable circumstances and Vice chair would regulate this meeting.

1. Secretary Address – Mohammed Arifuddin Sohel

- a. Meeting minutes of SEC 4 were reviewed and adopted.
- b. The activities of chapter and AG were presented based on webex usage, it was recommended to use L31 to present the events on a monthly basis in the secretary report
- c. Attendance in online events has improved in the last month due to the events being supported by student branch, but a few student branches are also reporting the L31 for the same event. It was decided that the Chapter Chair will take a final decision in deciding the organizational aspect of the event whether it will be collaborative event with SB or it will be supported by SB. This has to be done well in advance at the stage of preparation of brochure and everyone has clear idea of how L 31 has to be filed.
- d. Application for MGA Outstanding large section award has been submitted and the key points in the application process were discussed. The section needs to focus on the following criteria year on year to be having good chances of winning the word – Regular updates on Website, Minimum memberships and minimum event guidelines can be strictly followed, Formation of new units(Chapters/AG), Community projects, Technical, Professional and Education programs that project visibility of IEEE, Section awards, Members recruitment and communications,
- e. All chapter chairs are requested to prepare a report on the events conducted by their chapter in 2021 and send same to Secretary@ieeehyd.org by June 10. The services of chapter secretaries should be leveraged for this job.
- f. All chapter chairs were requested to train their execom members to use the Webex efficiently so that they have multiple resources for event management.

- i. Student branch events can be regulated with the cooperation of SAC and chapter chairs and where required the social media handle can be used for publicity. Chapter chairs recommendation will be crucial to offer the services of section webex, section social media handles and notices provided the events are announced with two weeks of lead time.














