







The meeting started at 7:30 PM through Online Mode.

S.No	Discussion Points [Action Points, Reports, Comments]							
1.	A brief opening note on the two upcoming events : Emerging Trends in AI/ML for Health Care Applications to be held on 17 th August,2023 at CBIT and Nurturing Strength within Talk to be held on 19 th August, 2023 at RGMCET and the required data to upload on Vtools is announced by the chair Dr.Harivardhagini S							
2.	It was announced that WIE AG Hyd. Section Congress is scheduled on 22nd Sep., 2023 at Vardhaman Engineering College Hyderabad. Dr.Sangeeta Singh will be coordinating this event from the host institution.							
3.	The committee discussed and brainstormed potential themes for the upcoming WIE AG Congress. Members were asked to share their ideas and suggestions for themes that align with the goals and objectives of the IEEE WIE. A decision on the final theme will be made in the upcoming meetings.							
4.	It was agreed that a budget of Rs.30,000 will be requested from the Hyderabad section for the WIE AG Congress. Dr. Harshavardhini was tasked with preparing a comprehensive budget proposal for the congress, taking into consideration all potential expenses and revenue sources.							
5.	The committee emphasized the importance of seeking sponsorship from other institutions and organizations to supplement the congress budget. Strategies for approaching potential sponsors and forming partnerships were discussed. Members were encouraged to leverage their networks to secure sponsorships.							
6.	The idea of organizing competitions during the congress was well-received. It was highlighted that these competitions should be open to all attendees and not limited by gender. Additionally, a panel discussion was proposed as a way to engage participants in meaningful discussions on relevant topics.							
7.	The committee decided on a nominal registration fee structure for attendees. IEEE student participants would be charged Rs200, while non-IEEE students would pay Rs 400. This fee structure aims to encourage IEEE participation while also accommodating non-IEEE attendees.							
8.	Members discussed the possibility of collaborating with other IEEE societies and chapters to meet the budget requirements for the congress. Collaborative efforts could involve sharing resources, co-hosting sessions, and pooling funds.							







9.	The EXCOM treasurer was assigned the responsibility of preparing the congress budget. The treasurer would refer to previous budget plans from other EXCOM members to ensure accuracy and comprehensiveness in the budget proposal.
10.	It was decided that each EXCOM student branch would aim to register a minimum of 20-25 students for the WIE AG Congress. This would contribute to the overall success of the event and help achieve the attendance goals.





Event Name: Advances in Healthcare, Image Processing and Internet Of Medical Things

For the last few decades, the developments in treatment methods and surgeries are increasing in healthcare, with the advancement of imaging systems, image processing, artificial intelligence techniques, robotics, high speed computing systems, large capacity storage devices, wide spread high speed internet and Wi-Fi facilities, lasers etc., Image processing has been playing a major role in easy diagnosis of diseases, non-invasive surgeries, remote surgeries, autonomous hospital facilities and many more activities for healthcare. Image processing and hyper-spectral or multi-spectral imaging techniques, greatly help diagnosing various eye diseases - like Glaucoma, Age related Macular Degeneration (AMD), Diabetic Retinopathy etc. Early stage detection of breast cancer is important to decrease the mortality rate. The Internet of medical things (IoMT) is another application for medical and health related areas, for creating a digitized healthcare systems, for treating patients from their homes and connecting available medical resources and healthcare services. To meet the worldwide demand for pathologists and for objective results. laboratories are incorporating digitization pathology with analytical software and artificial intelligence (AI). Pandemic has demanded lot, collaborative research between various healthcare companies and hospitals etc., to get healthcare from homes, which was changing patient safety from hospital to home. Key hole surgery and robotic surgery are taking important role in healthcare, giving advantage to patients for faster recovery and early return to work. Robotic surgeries are used for treating patients from remote places. Controlling robos with brain signal is another on going research. Students would have lot of scope to carry out projects and designing sub-systems in these areas. During the past years, hospitals are witnessing a decline in inpatient volumes along with a corresponding rise at outpatient utilization. This ongoing shift to the outpatient setting has been driven largely by advances in minimally invasive surgical techniques and advanced anesthesia techniques that allow patients to recover more quickly. Hospital on wheels facilitate employs in corporate companies to visit doctors, avail dental care, eyecare and availing minor surgical procedures, etc., Most challenging task is providing minimum Healthcare facilities for Rural and semi urban areas.
